

A SUMMARY OF SLD (DYSLEXIA) ASSESSMENT

Parents and teachers often ask what kinds of assessments should be done to determine the cause of a child's learning difficulties. Here is a flow chart showing the most appropriate things to look at. A teacher with experience could do some of these tests. Others require a speech pathologist or LD specialist, psychologist or other professional to do them. However, it helps to know what the likely contributing factors might be.
